

M I N U T E S  
WILLIAMSBURG BOARD OF EDUCATION  
DECEMBER 11, 2019

The Williamsburg Board of Education met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. in the High School Media Center on December 11, 2019. Members present were: Mark Armstrong, Brian Phillips, Kim Finn and Brooke Drahos. Matt Blythe was absent. The meeting was called to order by President Phillips.

Rachel Klein (ELP Coordinator) and a group of Mary Welsh students who are on the First Lego League Team presented their project for the regional competition later this month.

A motion was made by Finn, seconded by Drahos to approve the consent agenda as presented. Included in the consent agenda is the following: previous monthly minutes from the Board meeting on November 13, 2019; monthly claims; financial reports; approved a fundraiser for the boys and girls basketball teams to pump gas at The Depot; approved a fundraiser for the student council to host “almost half court shots”; approved a resignation from Ron Dalton as bus driver and swim shuttle driver, effective immediately; approved Heather McClanahan as wrestling cheer coach, Step 0, 3.5%; approved Mindy Wuebker as co-JH swim coach, Step 0, 6% (0.50 FTE); approved increasing Brandi Delveau’s contract from 0.20 FTE to 0.37 FTE; approved amending Todd Subbert’s job description to include Business and Industry Liaison; and approved Chris Hoeg as assistant high school baseball coach, Step 3, 7%. The motion passed unanimously.

The abstract of votes from the November 5, 2019 school board election was presented and received. There was a total of 392 votes cast for the two open 4-year terms. Mark Armstrong received 276 votes, Quinn Wolfe received 91 votes, and there was a scattering of 25 votes. Armstrong and Quinn will serve 4-year terms. There was a total of 258 votes cast for the one open 2-year term vacancy. Brooke Drahos received 246 votes and there was a scattering of 12 votes. Brooke Drahos will serve a 2-year term.

A motion was made by Finn, seconded by Armstrong to adjourn. Motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 6:50 p.m.
