WILLIAMSBURG BOARD OF EDUCATION
SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
JULY 31, 2020

The Williamsburg Board of Education met in special session at 8:21 a.m. in the High School Media Center and via Zoom meeting (in order to honor social distance recommendations due to Covid-19 virus concerns) on July 31, 2020. Members present were: Mark Armstrong, Quinn Wolfe, Brian Phillips, Kim Finn (via Zoom) and Brooke Drahos (via Zoom). The meeting was called to order by President Phillips.

During the public forum, Manda Marshall asked if comments could be made on Agenda Item #4 when that was discussed during the meeting. It was stated that all comments should be made during the public forum. No other comments were made.

A motion was made by Finn, seconded by Drahos to approve the consent agenda as presented. Included in the consent agenda is the following: approved a resignation from Dawn Burns as special ed associate; approved a resignation from Brenda Glandorf as special ed associate; approved Tonya Caron as special ed teacher, BA, Step 5; approved Teresa Mulvihil as 0.62 FTE preschool teacher, MA, Step 5; approved Matt Moffitt as science teacher, BA+24, Step 5. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Garber shared the model for returning to school on August 24, 2020. The model is to continue plans to return students and staff to school on a full-time, face-to-face basis for the 2020-2021 school year starting on August 24, 2020. For families with existing health conditions that make such a return more dangerous or for families who don't yet feel comfortable having students return to school, the District will offer fully online learning opportunities, to start approximately August 31, 2020. A motion was made by Wolfe, seconded by Armstrong to approve the school start model as presented. The motion passed unanimously.

A motion was made by Wolfe, seconded by Armstrong to adjourn. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 9:20 a.m. The next regular board meeting will be held on August 12, 2020 at 6:30 p.m.
